Rules

1. Parents will be punctual in dropping and picking children from school. Please allow yourself ample time to reach school in time.
2. Chewing gum is banned in the school.
3. Any wastage from snacks must be disposed in the bins.
4. No pupil is allowed to leave the school grounds during the hours of 10.30am and 1.00pm without the agreement of a school governor and the teacher concerned.
5. Whilst the school has a "no uniform" policy, pupils are advised to dress the common standard of decency. Caps should not be worn during class and assembly.
6. Pupils are not allowed to use mobile phones during school hours except during the break. Any child caught using a mobile phone will have it taken away for the day and handed to the parent collecting the child.
7. All users of the school will observe the traffic code in and out of the school.
